Subject: Anti-Bribery Policy

Fiscal Year 2026

Ban Mai Chaiyaphot Police Station is fully committed to enhancing integrity, transparency, and good governance. To build public trust and confidence, we hereby establish this Anti-Bribery Policy. All police officers and personnel are strictly required to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Objective

To prevent and combat all forms of corruption, bribery, or wrongful benefits, and to ensure that all duties and authorities are exercised with fairness and integrity.

2. Scope of Enforcement

This policy applies to all police officers, employees, and staff across all divisions under the jurisdiction of Ban Mai Chaiyaphot Police Station.

3. Definition of "Bribery"

"Bribery" refers to the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of money, property, gifts, tokens, or any other valuable benefits intended to induce or influence any person to act, refrain from acting, or delay an action in violation of their official duties, or to provide unfair advantages to themselves or others.

4. Measures and Sanctions Against Violators

Any personnel who violates this policy or is involved in bribery will face strict disciplinary actions to the highest extent and/or legal prosecution under relevant criminal laws without exception.

5. Monitoring and Auditing Measures

Ban Mai Chaiyaphot Police Station will implement an internal auditing system, a dedicated monitoring team, and an annual corruption risk assessment to actively monitor, detect, and prevent any bribery behaviors in all operations.

6. Whistleblowing and Complaint Channels

Complaints and clues regarding bribery can be reported through the following channels:

7. Protection of Whistleblowers, Complainants, Witnesses, and Confidentiality

The identity and information of whistleblowers, complainants, and witnesses will be kept strictly confidential. Access to such records is restricted to authorized personnel only to guarantee safety and prevent any retaliation, harassment, or negative consequences.
